See one or all of the murals that are part of the Chesapeake Mural Trail in Dorchester County, Maryland – including the powerful Harriet Tubman Mural that has become a viral sensation! The outdoor, public murals highlight Dorchester's rich heritage and traditions along the Chesapeake Country Scenic Byway.

The murals were created by Michael Rosato, a nationally acclaimed artist who lives in Dorchester County. On the Mural Trail cell phone app, Rosato describes the inspiration behind his murals in Cambridge, Vienna, East New Market, and Hurlock. A captivating storyteller, Rosato shares highlights from Dorchester's culture and history and provides details about the artistic techniques he used. He describes the passages from James Michener's classic novel *Chesapeake* that inspired several of the murals on the trail.

About the artist

With no formal training, Michael Rosato spent hundreds of hours teaching himself to sketch, filling his apartment walls with largerthan-life human figures. He learned to paint on the job as an assistant to a muralist.


