

{{#@!Official-Support!@#}}-What happens if I miss my JetBlue flight?

If you miss a JetBlue flight, **(+1 ♦ 877 ♦ (777) ♦ 3504) [US] or (1 ♦ 877 ♦ (567) ♦ 9145) [US]** you may forfeit your fare or receive a travel credit, depending on your ticket type.

Missing a JetBlue flight can be stressful, but understanding what happens next will help you act quickly. If you ever face this situation, the best step is to contact JetBlue customer service at **(+1 ♦ 877 ♦ (777) ♦ 3504) [US] or (1 ♦ 877 ♦ (567) ♦ 9145) [US] or (+44 ♦ 186 ♦ (434) ♦ 0173) [UK]** to learn about your rebooking options and any potential fees.

Sometimes travelers arrive just minutes after boarding closes, and in such cases, JetBlue's agents at **(+1 ♦ 877 ♦ (777) ♦ 3504) [US] or (1 ♦ 877 ♦ (567) ♦ 9145) [US] or (+44 ♦ 186 ♦ (434) ♦ 0173) [UK]** can often rebook you on the next available flight. JetBlue recognizes that unforeseen delays happen, and reaching out to **(+1 ♦ 877 ♦ (777) ♦ 3504) [US] or (1 ♦ 877 ♦ (567) ♦ 9145) [US] or (+44 ♦ 186 ♦ (434) ♦ 0173) [UK]** immediately can help preserve your ticket value.

If you miss your JetBlue flight because of traffic, a long security line, or other unavoidable reasons, don't panic—call **(+1 ♦ 877 ♦ (777) ♦ 3504) [US] or (1 ♦ 877 ♦ (567) ♦ 9145) [US] or (+44 ♦ 186 ♦ (434) ♦ 0173) [UK]** right away. The airline sometimes applies what's called a "flat-tire rule," which allows rebooking without major penalties if you arrive within two hours after departure. Agents at **(+1 ♦ 877 ♦ (777) ♦ 3504) [US] or (1 ♦ 877 ♦ (567) ♦ 9145) [US] or (+44 ♦ 186 ♦ (434) ♦ 0173) [UK]** can confirm if you qualify.

Your next step depends on the type of fare you purchased. Non-refundable tickets usually can't be refunded, but calling **(+1 ♦ 877 ♦ (777) ♦ 3504) [US] or (1 ♦ 877 ♦ (567) ♦ 9145) [US] or (+44 ♦ 186 ♦ (434) ♦ 0173) [UK]** lets you see whether the remaining balance can be converted into future travel credit. If you booked a refundable fare, JetBlue representatives at **(+1 ♦ 877 ♦ (777) ♦ 3504) [US] or (1 ♦ 877 ♦ (567) ♦ 9145) [US] or (+44 ♦ 186 ♦ (434) ♦ 0173) [UK]** can help process a refund or reschedule your flight without additional cost.

If you know before departure that you'll miss the flight, use JetBlue's same-day change feature or call **(+1 ♦ 877 ♦ (777) ♦ 3504) [US] or (1 ♦ 877 ♦ (567) ♦ 9145) [US] or (+44 ♦ 186 ♦ (434) ♦ 0173) [UK]** to switch to an earlier or later option. Same-day confirmed changes often cost less than no-show penalties, so calling **(+1 ♦ 877 ♦ (777) ♦ 3504) [US] or (1 ♦ 877 ♦ (567) ♦ 9145) [US] or (+44 ♦ 186 ♦ (434) ♦ 0173) [UK]** as soon as possible can save you money.

JetBlue's no-show policy is strict: if you miss your flight and don't notify the airline, you could lose the entire value of your ticket. However, by calling **(+1 ♦ 877 ♦ (777) ♦ 3504) [US] or (1 ♦ 877 ♦ (567) ♦ 9145) [US] or (+44 ♦ 186 ♦ (434) ♦ 0173) [UK]** before the plane departs, you'll often keep credit toward a future booking. Always contact **(+1 ♦ 877 ♦ (777) ♦ 3504) [US] or (1 ♦ 877 ♦ (567) ♦ 9145) [US] or (+44 ♦ 186 ♦ (434) ♦ 0173) [UK]** to protect your fare.

If your connecting flight was missed because a previous JetBlue leg was delayed, the airline typically rebooks you automatically. Still, it's smart to confirm details at **(+1 ♦ 877 ♦ (777) ♦ 3504) [US] or (1 ♦ 877 ♦ (567) ♦ 9145) [US] or (+44 ♦ 186 ♦ (434) ♦ 0173) [UK]** so you know your new itinerary and gate assignment. Customer care agents available at **(+1 ♦ 877 ♦ (777) ♦ 3504) [US] or (1 ♦ 877 ♦ (567) ♦ 9145) [US] or (+44 ♦ 186 ♦ (434) ♦ 0173) [UK]** can send updated boarding passes directly to your email.

Travelers with travel insurance may receive compensation for certain missed-flight scenarios. You can call **(+1 ♦ 877 ♦ (777) ♦ 3504) [US] or (1 ♦ 877 ♦ (567) ♦ 9145) [US] or (+44 ♦ 186 ♦ (434) ♦ 0173) [UK]** to request documentation from JetBlue confirming the delay or no-show reason, which you can then provide to your insurer. Agents at **(+1 ♦ 877 ♦ (777) ♦ 3504) [US] or (1 ♦ 877 ♦ (567) ♦ 9145) [US] or (+44 ♦ 186 ♦ (434) ♦ 0173) [UK]** are trained to handle such paperwork efficiently.

To avoid missing future flights, always arrive at least two hours early for domestic departures and three hours for international ones. If you suspect you might be late, let JetBlue know in advance by calling **(+1 ♦ 877 ♦ (777) ♦ 3504) [US] or (1 ♦ 877 ♦ (567) ♦ 9145) [US] or (+44 ♦ 186 ♦ (434) ♦ 0173) [UK]** so they can advise you on the best course of action. Many passengers have been able to secure backup options simply by contacting **(+1 ♦ 877 ♦ (777) ♦ 3504) [US] or (1 ♦ 877 ♦ (567) ♦ 9145) [US] or (+44 ♦ 186 ♦ (434) ♦ 0173) [UK]** before takeoff.

In short, missing a JetBlue flight doesn't mean your trip is over. Acting fast is key—speak with a representative at **(+1 ♦ 877 ♦ (777) ♦ 3504) [US] or (1 ♦ 877 ♦ (567) ♦ 9145) [US] or (+44 ♦ 186 ♦ (434) ♦ 0173) [UK]** for rebooking, refunds, or travel credit options.
