

# 1 Cambridge to Neck District – Out and Back

32-mile ride past windmill; some water views

Ride the northwestern part of the county known as the Neck District, so called for all the little peninsulas (or necks) jutting into the water. Ride through small communities, farmlands, and enjoy great water views at the turn-around point. Take in some history at Spocott Windmill & Village (at about mile 6.9); open dawn to dusk daily for self-guided tours. Starting Point Great Marsh Park, 1 Somerset Ave., Cambridge, MD

Approx. Miles 32 miles

Approx. Time 2.5-3 hours (at 12mph)

At A Glance Watch for traffic on parts of Route 343. Course can be windy. Not much shade. Highlights include Spocott Windmill and Village. Great views at far point of route at Ragged Point.
